Promptings

Jeff Cockerham has accepted a call to serve as lead counselor for Revivalist Wellness Center in Knoxville. As a result, he has offered his resignation as Associate Pastor of Discipleship effective March 15, 2019. This past Tuesday afternoon, Jeff's letter of resignation and an accompanying letter from me were emailed to church members.

While I grieve losing Jeff as a colleague, I am pleased he is following his sense of calling. I consider Jeff to be our missionary, someone whom we commission and bless to take the good news and presence of Christ into places most of us cannot go. I trust you will join me in supporting Jeff and Laura as they take this step on the road God has opened before them.

The Personnel Committee and I have taken the following actions to provide for covering a number of the ministries Jeff has provided.

- (1) The Senior Pastor will assume oversight of adult formation ministries, including Sunday School.
- (2) Cheyenne Duffy will continue in her role as Children's Ministry Assistant and take on additional responsibilities.
- (3) Josh Beeler and Cheyenne Duffy, who previously reported to Jeff, will report to the Senior Pastor.
- (4) Mike Smith and Josh Beeler will work with a group of proven supply preachers to round out the preaching calendar. The group includes persons such as Ron Mouser, Jeff Lane, and Eric Minton.
- (5) The ministerial staff will readjust their hospital visitation rotation schedule so as to ensure coverage.

We will monitor the situation and make other adjustments as needed.

In the meantime, I encourage you to speak words of appreciation and support to Jeff and Laura. Make plans to attend a reception in the Fellowship Hall on March 10, from 9am until 10:15, where we will honor them for their years of service and give them our blessings in their new endeavor.
