I'm grateful to James Bryan Smith (*The Good and Beautiful Community*, p. 103) for reminding me of the wise counsel once given by John Wesley.

John Wesley...offered five ways we can show love to those with whom we differ or disagree...

1. *Treat them as companions.*
2. *Do not think or speak evil of them.*
3. *Pray for them.*
4. *Encourage them to do good.*
5. *Collaborate with them in ministry.*

Wesley had a way of calling Christians to act in ways contrary to prevailing culture, both for their own sakes and in order to bear witness to Christ. Try applying his principles as you deal with social media, engage in conversations, evaluate various would-be leaders, and forge your own stance toward others.

Give it time, and you may well find yourself becoming someone who more nearly embodies the dictum Jesus gave us: "Do unto others, as you would have them do unto you."
