# Promptings

Each year, we take the CBCFC Summer Missions Offering during August and into September. The Missions Team reviews and sets the goal for the offering, and the team also determines how the offering will be distributed.

This year's offering will be distributed as follows.

State Missions: Fifty percent of the offering will go to state missions. Half of the sum will be forwarded to the Golden State Missions Offering (Tennessee Baptist Convention) and half to the Volunteer State Missions Offering (Tennessee Cooperative Baptist Fellowship).

Fountain City Ministry Center: Thirty percent of the offering will go to the Fountain City Ministry Center. The center is housed in our facility and staffed by volunteers from CBCFC and other churches in Fountain City. They provide food, children's clothing, and other services to Knox County residents in need.

Knoxville Leadership Foundation: Ten percent of the offering will go to the Knoxville Leadership Foundation. In this case, "Operation Backyard" will benefit from our gifts. "Operation Backyard" provides ramps and other such items for the elderly and disabled in our city.

Family Promise: Ten percent of the offering will go to Family Promise. Churches open their doors to provide temporary housing to those who have become homeless due to changes in their life situations. The ministry also provides food, companionship, and other forms of assistance.

As always, you may designate a specific ministry as the recipient of your gifts, if you so desire.
